# Free Supervised Playground Program

The Town of Vestal Recreation Department would like to invite your kids to spend a morning, afternoon or both in the park. A variety of crafts, games, literature, and special events will be provided for their enjoyment. Make new friends and create new memories. **All supervised playground activities are free and open to boys and girls ages 5 & up.** Children younger than five years are welcome to attend, but they must be accompanied by an adult. **See the calendar.** →

Next, register for the playground that your child wants to attend. **By registering online and filling out your cell phone number and carrier, we can text you on any program updates due to the weather.** The playground is a free drop-in program and even though the participants may not choose to attend every day, it is required to register.

**Inclement weather** sometimes forces us to close the parks. If it appears to be an all-day rain we will close the parks. If there is a storm during the program hours, for safety reasons, we will close the playground and send the children home. We may also close due to extreme heat warnings. 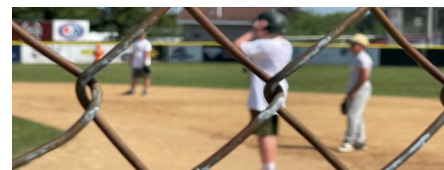

**September 7 - October 29**

This is an instructional program. Participants will learn different skills related to field hockey such as dribbling, passing, offensive & defensive moves and shooting through practices and games.

Practices are Wednesdays in September only from 6pm - dark (usually between 7:30pm - 8pm), plus two Saturday practices from 10am - noon. Tournaments typically begin the third Saturday of the season and run from 9am - 1pm. Tournaments are local to Broome & Tioga County. Teams are divided based on grades.

## **Barlow Park – Main Street**

Picnic shelter, tables, playground equipment, running water, stream, parking, electric.

## **Castle Gardens Park – Garden Lane**

Picnic shelter, tables, playground equipment, ball field, running water, no parking.

## **David Avenue Park – David Avenue**

Picnic shelter, tables, playground equipment, tennis court, basketball court, stream.

## **DEC Flood Fields – Main Street**

Soccer fields, ball field, golf practice.

## **Ethel Place Park – Ethel Park**

Picnic shelter, tables, playground equipment, basketball and kickball court, running water, no parking.

## **Fuller Hollow Park – Marietta Dr.**

Picnic shelter, table, playground equipment, stream, no parking.

## **Harold Moore Park – Old Vestal Rd.**

Picnic shelter, tables, playground equipment, softball fields, two full court basketball courts, rest rooms, running water, soccer fields, electric, river access, boat ramp, parking.

## **Jones Park – State Line Road**

Nature trail, stream, hiking, cross country skiing, parking. Dogs allowed on leash. Trail map available.

## **Memorial Park - Four Corners - Rt. 434 & Front St.**

Band Gazebo, electric, park benches, and six free summer band concerts on Tuesdays at 7:00 PM in June and July. Schedule on page # 9. On street parking only.

## **Middendorf Park – Juneberry Rd.**

Picnic shelter, tables, playground equipment, ball field, running water, parking.

## **Richards Ave. Park – Richards Ave.**

Picnic shelter, tables, playground equipment, no parking, running water.

## **Ross Corners Park – Old Owego Rd.**

Tennis courts, soccer field, running water, parking.

## **Stair Park – Murray Hill Rd.**

Picnic shelter, tables, playground equipment, running water, parking, electric.

## **Stratford Park – Stratford Dr.**

Picnic shelter, tables, playground equipment, running water, no parking.

## **Twin Orchards – Myrtle Street**

Picnic shelter, tables, playground equipment, ball field, running water, parking and access to Rail Trail.

## **Vestal Center Park – Coleman St.**

Picnic shelter, playground equipment, tennis courts, ball field, basketball court, running water, parking.

## **Willow Point Park – Gates Rd.**

3 softball fields.

## **Vestal Rail Trail**

Both trails equal total of 3.55 miles. The trails 2.1 mile section runs between North Main Street and African Road and is located just north of and parallel to the Vestal Parkway (Rt. 434). The trail has a twelve foot paved path with eight feet of grass on either side. Parking is at Stage Rd. and on the east side of the Shoppes at Vestal. The trail has benches. Bathrooms are located at both ends of trail. The newer section runs from the western end of the existing trail on N. Main St. and proceeds west, 1.45 miles to Castle Gardens Rd., paralleling Rt. 17. Parking is located at a vacant lot on Castle Gardens Road.

## **Picnic Shelter Rentals**

There are four picnic shelters at Arnold Park. The shelters are rented by the day. Cost is \$30.00 Residents & \$50.00 Non Residents Monday - Thursday, \$75.00 Residents & \$95.00 Non Residents Friday - Sundays. Alcohol is permitted for \$50.00 additional fee, any day, and you must provide an insurance certificate, listing the Town of Vestal as additionally insured.
