





Red Cross Swim Levels

Please use the age group as a guideline only.

Students may be placed in the level that best corresponds with their swimming ability. (Swim lessons are at Vestal High School)

Suggested AGES	Level	Approximate Ability
6 months to 3 years	Parent/Child An Adult must get into the water with child!	Promotes water enrichment for young children with the comfort of a trusted adult in the water. 'Parents' and kids will learn water readiness together through activities and songs.
3 years to 5 years	Preschool Levels 1 - 3	Geared for kids who are able to get into the water with an adult present. Kids will learn to become comfortable in the water by themselves and will learn basic swim through fun activities.
6 years and older	Learn to Swim Levels 1 - 3 Beginner	Kids will be assessed on their abilities and placed accordingly in a class on the first day. Level 1 is recommended for kids who are comfortable in the water but cannot keep themselves afloat without assistance. Level 3 is recommended for kids who can swim short distances without a floatation device or are ready to.
8 years and older	Learn to Swim Levels 1 - 3 Intermediate	Kids at this level should have a basic knowledge of all strokes and be comfortable swimming laps the width of the deep end. Kids will refine their strokes and build endurance in the water.
10 years and older	Learn to Swim Levels 1 - 3 Advanced	Kids at this level should be accustomed to swimming longer distances in the deep end and be able to preform all strokes. Kids will continue to refine and perfect strokes, build endurance swim with power and efficiency and prepare for competition.

All Swim lessons are at the Vestal High School indoor pool on Woodlawn Dr. Monday - Friday

All lessons will be taught using the Red Cross swim lessons curriculum. Classes will be conducted Monday – Friday in two-week sessions. Classes are held at the Vestal High School Indoor Pool. Classes cancelled due to special events or pool maintenance problems are not made up and there is no refund. When registering your child, choose the level that best corresponds with your child's age and/or swimming ability. See the Red Cross swimming level chart on page # 10 for further reference. When selecting a class, please consider your child's maturity, water comfort and prior swimming experience. If you are unsure of the placement for your child, we recommend the lower level. The child's confidence will flourish if he/she is in the top portion of the class rather than the bottom. A child may repeat any swim level several times before passing. First Day of Classes: Children are evaluated by instructors and placed into groups according to ability. There may be some adjustments made as instructors get to know the children better. Enter the Vestal High school through the main front doors and follow the labeled cones to the pool.

Last Day of Classes: Red Cross achievement cards will be issued. Questions: If you have any questions or concerns regarding placement of your child, please feel free to speak with the onsite Pool Directors or call the Recreation Department at 607-754-3368. To Register: Go to vestalrecreation.com.



Both trails equal a total of 3.55 miles. The trails 2.1 mile section runs between North Main Street and African Road and is located just north of and parallel to the Vestal Parkway (Rt. 434). The trail has a twelve foot paved path with eight feet of grass on either side. Parking is at Stage Rd. and on the east side of the Shoppes at Vestal. The trail has benches. Bathrooms are located at both ends of trail. The newer section runs from the western end of the existing trail on N. Main St. and proceeds west, 1.45 miles to Castle Gardens Rd., paralleling Rt. 17. Parking is located at a vacant lot on Castle Gardens Road.

- In Person: You can pay in person during business hours by cash, check, or credit card. 24/hour mail slot is available for after hours drop off. Drop-off does not guarantee immediate enrollment. We will notify you if a program is full. Office address is 516 Front Street, Vestal.

Registration Deadline: We accept registrations until an activity is full. If we do not get enough participants to run the program, we will cancel and refund you. If registering for an activity that includes a t-shirt, you must register three weeks before program starts to guarantee correct size.

Fees: All fees must be paid in full and are due at the time of registration. Partial payments are not accepted. All checks and money orders are made out to: Town of Vestal. Refund requests must be emailed to kwickman@vestalny.gov and made no less than one week prior to the start of the activity.
